## What you said you didn't like about the village in which you live

Traffic	Crime & anti-social behaviour	Public transport	Shops & pubs
The most frequently occurring response. Over 51% of you raised concerns over the increase in volume of traffic, speed of vehicles, lack of traffic calming measures, and how new development will exacerbate these problems.	19% of you are unhappy about the lack of police presence, anti-social behaviour (particularly young people riding bikes in the road and on common land), and an increase in crime locally.	15% of residents are unhappy about the lack of public transport, the frequency of buses, and no train link to Epping train station.  Other issues identified include concerns about new development and housing, lack of medical facilities, nothing for the young to do, and the loss of the countryside.	14% of you commented on the lack of choice of local shops and pubs, and having no ATM facilities.

## What the under 16s thought

**40%** of the under 16s who responded like the open and green spaces in their village, having space to play and walk/cycle. They also like having parks and playgrounds (although the playgrounds could be bigger and better!)

**25%** mentioned they would like to see more sporting activities, suggesting a swimming pool, skate park, gym, football facilities, and sports/leisure centre.

Concerns over being able to safely cross the road and the speed of the traffic were also frequently mentioned, as well as better public transport links.

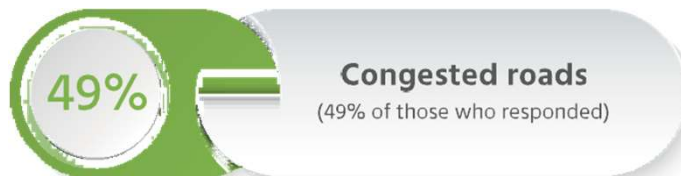

The Grade II listed Control Tower should be retained and used for local community or public use

The continued use and enhancement of North Weald Airfield for aviation, flying and all related activities will be supported. Recreational aviation will be encouraged

New commercial buildings must not be of a size that detrimentally affects the current or future aviation operation of the airfield

Proposals for new employment uses on the Airfield should be designed to ensure HGV access is from Rayley Lane / Merlin Way to the north eastern side of the Airfield

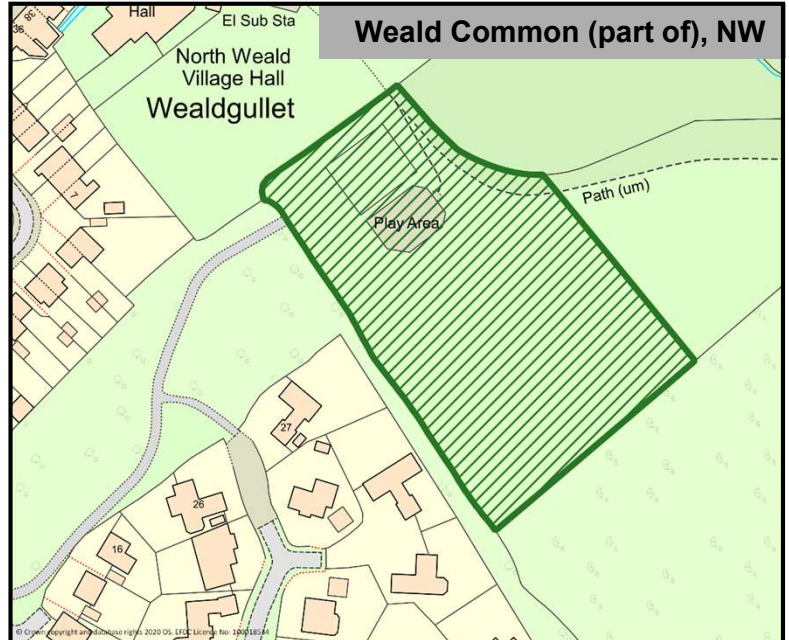

**Village Greens, Wheelers Farm Gardens, NW**



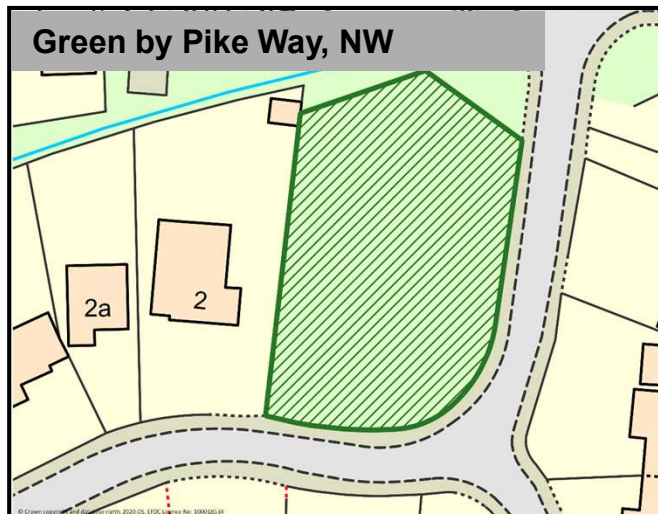
**Weald Common (part of), NW**



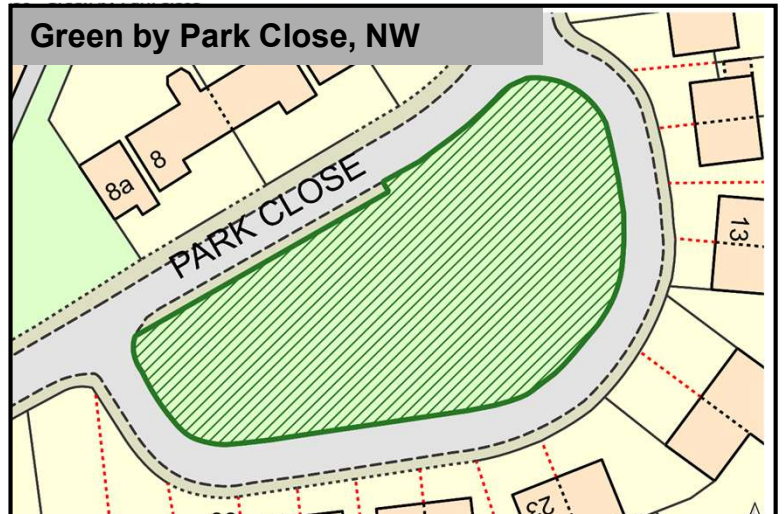

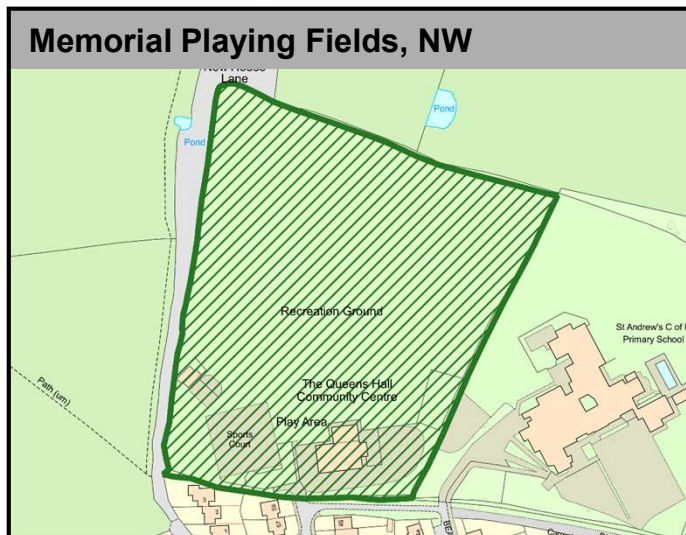
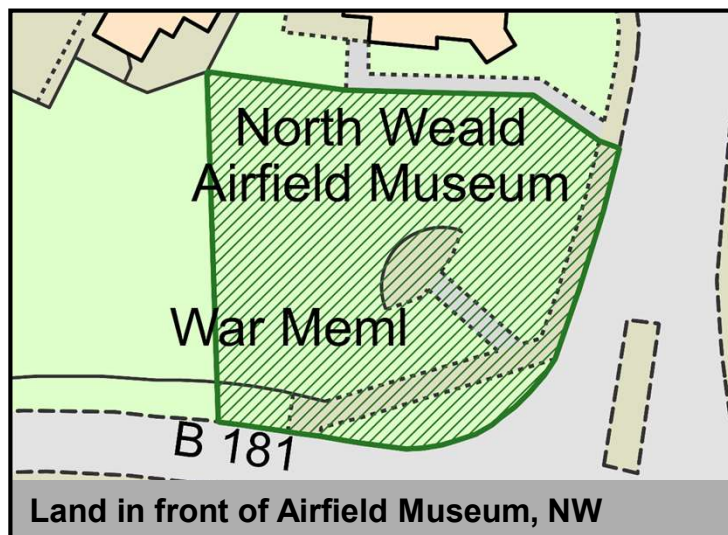
