## 6. DEVOLUTION AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT REORGANISATION

On 19<sup>th</sup> November 2025, the Government launched its public consultation on Local Government Reorganisation (LGR) proposals, asking members of the public and interested parties for their opinions. The consultation specifically wants responses from Parish and Town Councils. The consultation ends on 11<sup>th</sup> January 2026. An Extraordinary meeting of the Parish Council was held on 15<sup>th</sup> December 2025 to consider the matter, however it was agreed to hold a further meeting on 5<sup>th</sup> January 2026 to further consider the matter, to which the District Councillors would be asked to attend and explain their rationale for a 3 Tier proposal.

Councillors are asked to *CONSIDER* and *AGREE* their response to the current consultation.
