## 6. PATHWAY AT WEALD COMMON WORKING GROUP ${ }^{\text {Nal }}$

At the Parish Council Meeting on Monday, 2 March 2015, Councillors agreed that a Working Group should be set up to discuss the pathway at Weald Common. It was suggested that the Working Group consist of three Members of the Parish Council and three Members of the Village Hall Committee, together with a member of staff from the Parish Council to assist with administration. Members of this Committee are now asked to AGREE who will participate in the Working Group.

## 7. 资ALLOTMENT SUB-COMMITTEE ${ }^{\text {sly }}$

A verbal update regarding any allotment issues will be given at the meeting.
a) Allotment Wardens
i) Hastingwood A

Members of this Committee are asked to CONSIDER whether the Parish Council's Allotment Sub-Committee continues to carry out the role of warden at Hastingwood A for the forthcoming year.
ii) Thornwood

The Parish Office has been advised that Mr Montgomery will no longer be carrying out the role of warden for the forthcoming year. Members of this Committee are asked to CONSIDER whether the Parish Council's Allotment Sub-Committee carry out the role of warden or whether an allotment tenant is appointed to the role.
b) Allotment Fees

Members of this Committee are asked to CONSIDER a possible increase in allotment fees for 2016/17. An increase of $10 \%$ was agreed in March 2014 and Members are reminded that the Parish Council is required to give 12 months notice of any increase. The Allotment fees for the current year are as follows:

- Under 50 sqm $=$ Extra small £17.00
- Between 51sqm \& 100sqm = Small £18.50
- Between 101sqm \& 150sqm = Average £20.00
- Between 151sqm \& 200sqm = Large $£ 22.00$
- Over 201sqm = Extra Large £24.00
c) Annual Allotment Meeting

Members of this Committee are REMINDED that the Annual Meeting of Allotment Holders is scheduled to take place on Sunday, 22nd March 2015, 9.30am for 10am start, at the Parish Hall Thornwood Common. Refreshments will be available. All Councillors are invited to attend.
d) Bonfires

A request has been received from an allotment tenant on Hastingwood A site regarding extending the period currently granted for the lighting of bonfires. The Code of Practice currently states that "bonfires may not be lit, under any circumstances, during the period $1^{\text {st }}$ April to $31^{\text {st }}$ October inclusive, out of consideration for other tenants and nearby residents". Members are asked to CONSIDER this request.

## 8. 塈CEMETERY

a) Increase in Cemetery Fees

Members of this Committee are asked to CONSIDER a possible increase in cemetery fees for 2015/16. Last year it was agreed by this Committee that fees should be increased by $10 \%$ (rounded up to the nearest $£ 1$ ). A copy of the current fees is attached at APPENDIX 2.
