5. NEIGHBOURHOOD AREA PLAN

Members were previously circulated copies of a letter from Epping Forest District Council, together with an email from Green Planning Studios, which included an opinion from Michael Rudd, the Barrister representing the Parish Council.

As Members are aware, the decision was taken to go forward with the Judicial Review at the 22nd June Extraordinary Meeting, however, due to the content of both the letter and the email, a decision was necessary to be taken by the 23rd July whether or not to continue with the Judicial Review process.

The Clerk circulated a letter, which was self explanatory, advising Members that a decision needed to be taken at extremely short notice. Three Members of this Council signed a notification to this effect, thereby this is why this meeting has been called to **RATIFY** this decision.

Due to this Council being in recess during August, Members are respectfully asked to leave any discussions on this matter until the Full Parish Council Meeting to be held in September.
