5. HARLOW & GILSTON GARDEN TOWN - SPATIAL VISION [®]

 \blacksquare At the Parish Council Meeting on Monday 2^{nd} July, Members were advised of the above spatial vision consultation which included the consultation on Latton Priory.

Members were advised of the details of the Exhibition together with the deadline for comments which is the <u>27th July.</u> The Clerk advised that if Members agreed, comments could be made by the Planning Committee and then ratified at the next Parish Council Meeting. Members discussed this matter after which some Members felt that the views of the Planning Committee may not necessarily be those views of all the Members of the Parish Council and therefore they wished an Extraordinary Meeting to be held as this item was a very important item for this
