## 4. BUDGET AND PRECEPT 2014/2015 $\checkmark$

Members may recall at the November 2013 Finance and General Purposes meeting, a 0% increase in the budget for 2014/2015 was agreed (which was ratified at the December Parish Council meeting).

The precept for last year was  $\pounds 152,002$  (made up of a  $\pounds 13,265$  Parish Support Grant from EFDC, and the **official** precept amount of  $\pounds 138,815$ ). Members may recall that it was

decided to 'view' the precept as being  $\pounds 152,002$  so as not to show an 8.6% reduction in the precept (which was one of our concerns, and a letter was in fact written to EFDC explaining the Parish Councils concerns).

For 2014/2015, the precept was modelled on the same calculations, with the reduction in support grant being received for 2014/2015 being factored in (£11,461). By continuing with the calculations used for last year (viewing the precept at £152,002) technically we see that we haven't increased our precept, i.e. it remains at £152,002.

As perceived this is now causing a problem, in that in order to reach the £152,002, we would need to put in a precept request to District Council of £140,541 (as opposed to £138,815) in order to reach the £152,002 which will show a 1.24% increase.

However, in order to resolve this issue, it is **PROPOSED** that the following takes place:

- 1. The difference of £1,726 is taken from the £20,000 car park fund, reducing the car park fund to £18,274, therefore meaning **the 0% increase in precept is retained**.
- 2. That the precept for the Parish Council is calculated and *VIEWED* as its proper amount  $(\pounds 140,541)$  for both this year and also going forward so that this misinterpretation does not re-occur. (Councillors are asked to *NOTE* that whilst this would look as though the Parish Council has reduced its precept, the way District Council manages Parish Council funds means <u>WE</u> have to amend our process to accommodate this).

Councillors are asked to *NOTE* that unless this change is made, the same issue will reoccur next year, as the District Council believes a further 14.1 reduction in Parish Support Grant will take place next year. It is our understanding that a number of local councils have now created contingency funds (named under various headings) to accommodate these anticipated reductions over the coming years.
