8. PLANNING CORRESPONDENCE

The Clerk has received the following notifications:-

a) LOCAL ENFORCEMENT PLAN CONSULTATION

BAs part of the new localism agenda members will be aware that the Government has introduced the National Planning Policy Framework as planning guidance.

Regarding the planning enforcement function, under Section 207 of the Framework, "Local planning authorities should consider publishing a local enforcement plan to manage enforcement proactively, in a way that is appropriate to their area. This should set out how they will monitor the implementation of planning permissions, investigate alleged cases of unauthorised development and take action where it is appropriate to do so".

Attached, at *APPENDIX 1*, is a draft Local Enforcement Plan (LEP) for consultation EFDC wish to have comments on this by Friday 31 May 2013. Members are therefore asked to advise the Acting Clerk of any COMMENTS OR CONCERNS they may have either prior to or at the meeting. Once this consultation is finished the draft plan (amended if required) will be placed before District Councillors for adoption.

Please note this process is **NOT** linked in any way with the new Local Plan and is a separate stand alone matter.

b) Town and Country Planning Act 1990: Notification of Planning Application Address: Land to rear of 59-61 High Road, North Weald, Epping, Essex Proposal: Erection of single bungalow on land to rear. The application has been withdrawn by the applicant and therefore no further action on this application will be taken.

c) Town and Country Planning Act 1990: Notification of Planning Application Address: Camfaud Concrete Pumps Ltd, High Road, North Weald Bassett, Epping, Essex CM16 6LU

Proposal: Demolition of existing office building and removal of portable cabins. Construction of new office extension to workshop.

The application has been withdrawn by the applicant and therefore no further action on this application will be taken.

GYPSY & TRAVELLER ISSUES – TRAINING SESSION - Monday 13th May 5.30pm at Epping Town Council, St. Johns Road, Epping

Last year the Planning Advisory Service (PAS) offered a training session to the District Council on the new Government guidance on planning for traveller sites. It has taken a while to finally arrange this, but the date, location and time are now agreed as above. The main speaker is the Leader of South Somerset District Council (Ric Pallister), and he will be supported by three colleagues.

Officers from the District Council sent PAS a draft agenda last August (details are shown below) and Mr Pallister will address these issues as well as outlining the duties under Housing and Planning legislation. He will also present and discuss five case studies which raise issues of particular interest. If the District Council cannot show that adequate provision is being made for the travelling community in the new Local Plan, it is probable that the Plan will be judged unsound at Examination in Public. This is a nettle that has to be grasped, and it is hoped that the training session will enable Members and Parish Council attendees to deal with this difficult issue with more confidence.

The draft agenda sent to PAS included the following:

- 92% Green Belt making land elsewhere unaffordable to the travelling community. With such a significant restraint, how can this Council identify a 5-year deliverable land supply and update this annually;
- Significant concentration of the community in only 2 of the district's 24 parishes;
- Very significant and persistent negative reaction by sections of the settled community;
- Make-up of the local travelling community separate and discrete small family groupings, although there are some extended families - no known local support groups;
- Future engagement will be very resource intensive with no guarantee of useful results or outputs;
- Duty to Co-operate collaborative working between Councils is highly unlikely;
- Definition of the term "local connections" in the guidance;
- How can the Council ensure that sites which may be identified are genuinely deliverable;
- Known reluctance of developers/housebuilders to make provision for the travelling community on large sites;
- The (probable) reluctance of the travelling community to have their sites identified on "Adopted Policies" maps.

The session is expected to be well attended, although places are restricted due to the capacity of the room therefore only one place was made available per Town or Parish Council. The Finance and Administration Officer has been dealing with the local plan and will attend the session on behalf of the Council.
