- 4 The photographs are not truly representative ie dates etc.
- 5 The details that have been given regarding the sizes and heights of the planning stacks are incorrect the local residents who live nearby advise they have never been that high.
- 6 Has an Environmental Impact Assessment Disclosure ever been carried out?
- Has an assessment been carried out regarding the open air Restaurant at McDonalds and Harlow Garden Centre, both of which are within 100 metres of the proposal.
