The Parish Council **OBJECTS** to this Application on the grounds that the proposal:

Affects local residents by noise impact

The noise levels are already at unacceptable levels -

Two weeks ago Environmental Services visited a local resident and the envirimonental officer(Richard Tomlinson) that noise can be heard through double glazing and over the TV.

Concrete crushing is not an acceptable activity to take place in the Green Belt. Residents are concerned about any changes to the current boundary will bring the sounds and noise from this site closer to their homes.

Current application contains no proposals to lessen the noise. The bund actually increases the noise and does not lessen it.

This Council is concerned with regard to the comments on the first page of the statement, if planning permission is granted it will allow the council to have some control. This is not the case, there does not seem to have been any control over the site.

We also express concern about the quality of life of people who live in Upland Rd and in Thornwood Common.

Members felt that the applicant continues to put in applications each time he receive a threat of enforcement action from EFDC. The applicant has advised that by putting in a planning application they feel this application will help resolve the long term problem regarding enforcement action. Members felt that this is happening time and time again.

The Parish Council therefore reiterates that it **OBJECTS** to this Application as asks the District Council to take Immediate Enforcement Action.

P13.038 ANY OTHER MATTERS RELATING TO PLANNING

Discussion regarding notification of the decision of the future of North Weald Airfield:-

Councillor Stallan advised members that the decision had been subject to a Call In and would now go to a meeting of the Overview and Scrutiny Committee. He advised that the date of the meeting was next Tuesday (27.8.13) at 7.30pm. The decision was "called in" by six non members of the Cabinet, who disagreed with the decision made by Cabinet (non members were three from Chigwell, one fromBuckhurst Hill, 1 from Theydon Bois and 1 from Waltham Abbey). He informed Members of the way the Votes at the Cabinet meeting on 22 July had been cast and which were as follows:-

- Cllrs Stallan and Grigg voted for Option 1 they were the only two who voted in favour of that option.
- 1 voted for Option 2a
- 9 voted against Option 2b
- 9 voted for Option 3 this was a unanimous vote.

Councillor Blanks asked the following:-

- 1. What would be the optimum time for people to arrive (at meeting) Cllr Stallan said to be there for about 6.30pm.
- 2. Of those 15, if it went 8/7 either way, would it be subject to another calling? Cllr Stallan said no the Cabinet can reaffirm its decision it doesn't have to listen to Overview and Scrutiny. Third option would be to send it to full council if it goes this route, it then goes to the Monitoring Officer and Chief Financial Officer however, no advice from Ian Willett could be given until they had received the call in.

Cllr Grigg also advised Members of some additional matters that may take place.
